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The dining area, which is situated between the kitchen and the great room, is the ideal place to gather with family and friends to enjoy meals while taking in the scenery.

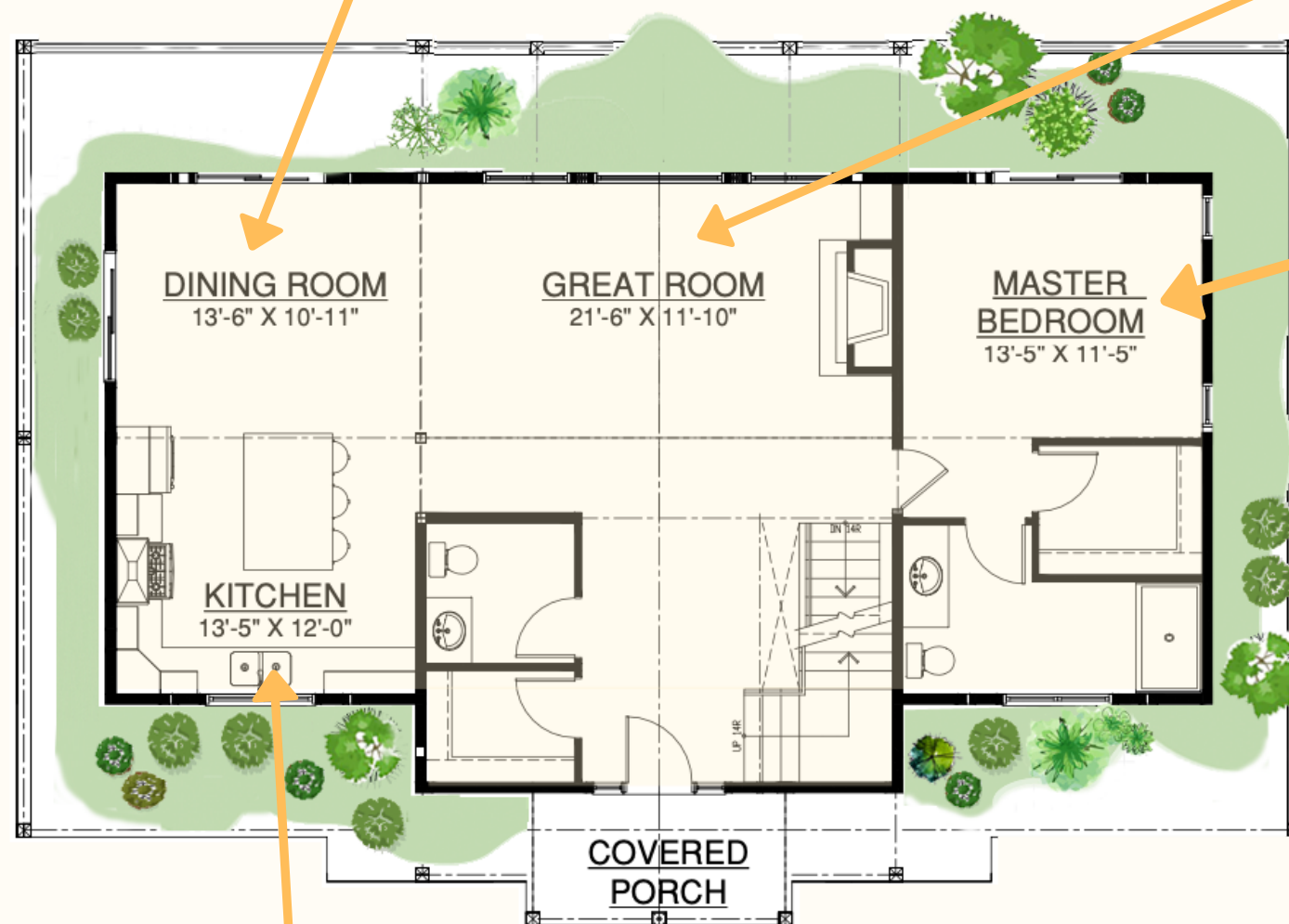
